**Sub: Mass Demonstration & Rally by NCCOEEE & Federal Executive Meeting of
AIPEF on 08th December' 2014 at New Delhi –Reg**

You are aware that the AIPEF Federal Executive has decided to organize a Mass Demonstration & Rally at New Delhi during coming winter session of Parliament in co-ordination with **National Co-ordination Committee of Electricity Employees & Engineers (NCCOEEE)** in protest against the anti-people policies in Power Sector in India.

In this connection, NCCOEEE has a given call to hold Mass Demonstration & Rally of Electricity Employees & Engineers on 8th December'2014 at 11.00AM at JANTAR MANTAR, NEW DELHI with the participation of members of its Constituent Federations at national level (**All India Power Engineers Federation, All India Federation Of Power Diploma Engineers, All India Federation Of Electricity Employees (AITUC), Akhil Bhartiya Vidyut Mazdoor Sangh(BMS), Electricity Employees Federation Of India(CITU), All India Power Men's Federation, Hind Mazdoor Sabha)** and their affiliated Unions & Associations at state level.

Shri. A.B.Bardhan, Convener of NCCOEEE has informed vide circular dt.06/10/2014 that the respective Federations, Unions & Associations shall hold meetings, distribute posters & Hand bills and make preparation for the Rally with Banners & Placards containing demands & Slogans.

In view of the above, you are requested to mobilize maximum strength from your state unit to participate in the rally and make it a grand success.

Further, it is also decided to hold AIPEF Federal Executive meeting on same day after the Rally at New Delhi to discuss about further course of action and deliberate upon other developments concerning Power Sector in India.

The Main Demands of the AIPEF & NCCOEEE to be highlighted at the Rally are:

- Review Electricity Act'03 in view of total failure of so called reforms in Power Sector aimed to promote privatization during last two decades & withdraw the proposed anti-people amendments to Electricity Act'03.
- Stop Unbundling/Privatising/Franchising of Power Utilities in Generation, Transmission & Distribution.
- Roll Back Dirty Privatisation of Delhi & Odisha DISCOMs.
- Cancel all urban electricity distribution franchisee agreements of Agra, Nagpur, Aurangabad, Jalgaon, Bhiwandi, Gaya, Bhagalpur, Muzaffarpur, Ujjain, Sagar, Gwalior, Ranchi & Jamshedpur cities.
- Stop Outsourcing/Contract system in Power Utilities & fill up all vacant posts through regular recruitments immediately.
- CAG Audit be made mandatory for all private companies engaged in generation, transmission, distribution & trading of electricity.
- Ensure Power to All at affordable rates by strengthening Public Sector Power Utilities.

In this regard, you are requested to give wide publicity among electricity engineers & employees and general public through seminars /workshops/ press statements about the above demands and urgent need to review the ongoing Power Policies and privatization in Power Sector which are not in the interest of the people of the country.

Further, it is also requested to interact and co-ordinate with other Unions & Associations of your state and make them to participate in the Rally irrespective of their affiliation to National Level Federations & NCCOEEE.

Finally, you are requested to attend the Rally and Federal Executive meeting without fail and take personal interest to mobilize maximum strength to participate in the Mass Demonstration & Rally at JANTAR MANTAR, New Delhi on 08th December'2014.
